


Avenue Kleber & Jardins du Trocadéro

History

Kleber avenue was laid out in accordance with Baron Haussmann's plans of 1854. The Raphaël is located on this avenue. The square, place du Trocadéro, was laid out in 1858. A Moorish-inspired edifice was then built for the 1878 Exhibition wich in 1937 made way for the present Chaillot Palace. Jardins du Trocadéro were designed for the 1937 Exhibition. Beyond the walls on either side of the long rectangular pool on an axis with the léna bridge, the final slopes of Chaillot Hill lead down, beneath flowering trees, to the bank of the Seine.
